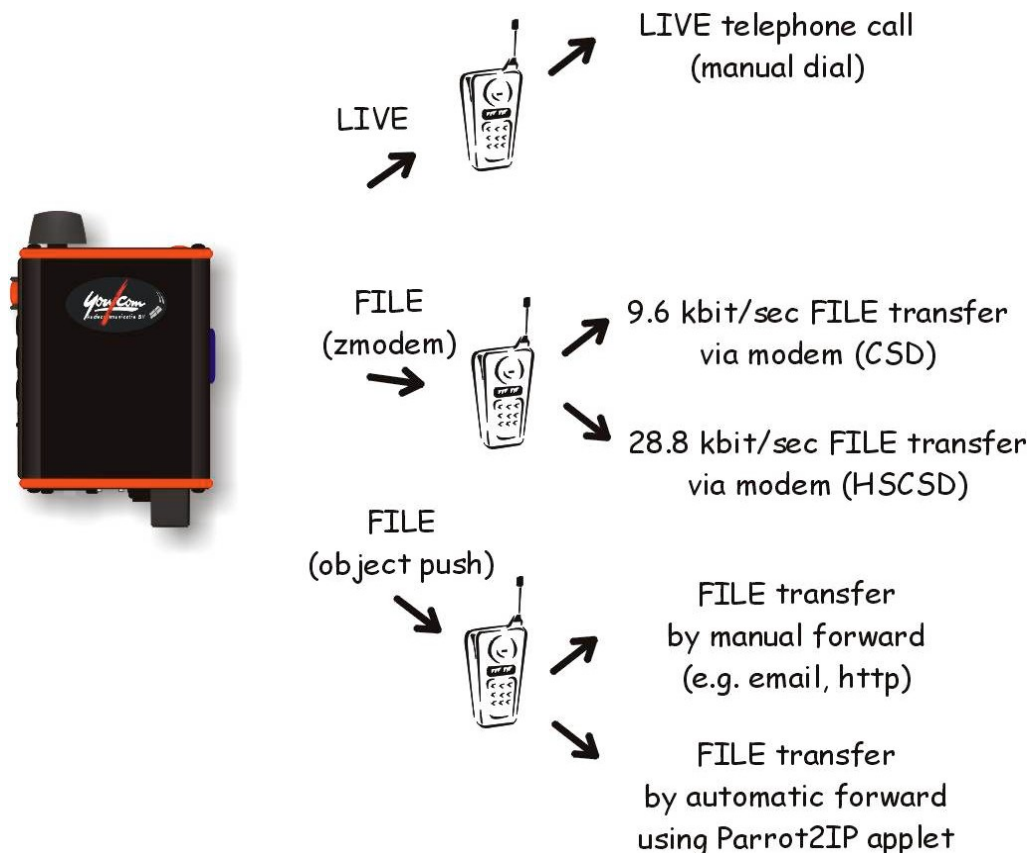


## File-transfer options with Parrot



The idea behind the development of the PARROT was to build a multi-functional device that fulfils a reporter's daily requirements. A device, that works with the equipment already in his possession such as a laptop, a PDA or a mobile phone. The PARROT therefore has standard interfaces (XLR, 6,3mm headphones jack, USB and SD-card) so that it can connect to and work with existing equipment. But even more importantly, it has a Bluetooth interface for voice and data. And so instead of the PARROT the mobile phone or Smartphone has become the "connection" to the outside world.

We all know that better and smarter mobile phones that work with even faster networks will continue to come to market. However, we believe it is better to leave it up to the Nokias, Motorolas, Sony Ericssons etc. of this world to accommodate these new and faster networks. That is their core business. It is our job to make clever connections to the services that these mobile devices offer.
